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- Why Plant Native?**
1. Requires Less Watering - Native plants are adapted to local precipitation patterns and have long roots to reach water deep in the soil.
 2. No Fertilizers / Pesticides Needed - Native plants are adapted to natural conditions, including local pests, soil types and soil nutrients.
 3. Reduces Erosion & Runoff - Native plants have deep roots that stabilize the soil and aid in water absorption.
 4. Provides Wildlife Habitat - Local wildlife is adapted to the properties of native plants which provide critical food and shelter to them.
